The mayor called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Kirk Stelly, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

Matthew Vincent with Sellers & Associates presented the following on the Street Project. Contractor will mobilize to do additional work due to funding balance.

WWTP improvements project, contractor anticipates mobilizing mid-July. Engineer recommends approval of Partial Payment Estimate No. 1 for \$30,078.90. Motion by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Amanda Herpin, and all in favor of approving to pay PPE #1 contingent on issuing a Notice to Proceed starting July 25, 2026 to complete in 60 day.
