

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEONVILLE, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 10, 2024, AT 6:00 PM IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville was held on Tuesday, December 10, 2024, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter, Council Members Billy Lanclos, Kirk Stelly, Kerry Willingham, Benita Kennerson, Amanda Herpin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Billy Lanclos, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

Chad Hardy, Republican State Central Committee did not appear.

Greg Wyble, sewer issue when it rains at 2693 Hwy 347. Maintenance Dept. is aware, smoke test was already performed and working to fix issue.

Shirley Vige gave Audit Report, town is in good standing.

Mayor informed council that COLA is 2.5% for annual raise.

Mayor informed council that effective 12/31/24 billing, according to Ordinance No. 1 of 2023, Water Overage rate is \$3.51, Water Overage Discounted rate(CBS) is \$3.16, and Sewer Overage rate is \$4.24.

Motion by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Billy Lanclos, all in favor for Blake Davis to represent Leonville on the Fire District 5 Board effective January 1, 2025.

Blake Davis, Supervisor, gave report. Sanitary survey complete, sewer lift station having issues with wipes.

Engineering Report, Church Road Reconstruction Project complete, Street Improvement Project plans and specs being submitted to FP&C. Water Sector Program-Phase 2 application is due Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup>. WWTP Project approval received from LDH can schedule advertising for bids.

On a Motion by Amanda Herpin, seconded by Benita Kennerson, all in favor authorizing Sellers & Associates to advertise for bids.

Additional business, Mayor presented Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between the town and Louisiana Department of Veterans Affairs. On a motion by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Amanda Herpin, and all in favor to approve.

There being no further business, the meeting was declared adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
