Jacob Moreau, Fire District No. 5 informed council that RFP for Architect did go out for new fire hall.

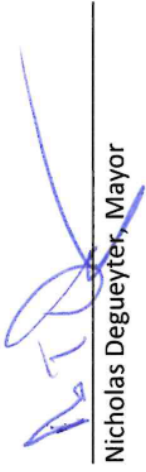
Engineering report was given. Resident on Lemelle St has not paid for culvert that was replaced for Street Project to proceed, payment must be collected or culvert will be removed.
