

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEONVILLE, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, JULY 13, 2021, AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville, Louisiana, was held on Tuesday, July 13, 2021, at 6:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter and Council Members Billy Lanclos, Benita Kennerson, Kerry Willingham, and Kirk Stelly. Absent was Brandon Herpin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted on a motion by Kirk Stelly, seconded by Kerry Willingham and carried.

Sarah Dake, Regional Representative for Senator John Kennedy, addressed the council advising if there was ever a need by the town or a resident to please contact her. Senator Kennedy would do all he could in any matters needed.

Waterworks District #3 presented a water purchase contract to the Town of Leonville requesting to purchase bulk water for approximately 635 customers in the following area: East of the Town of Port Barre, North of Hwy 190, South of Bayou Courtableau and East to the Hwy 71 area. Council will lookover contract and get back with the Waterworks District #3 in 30 days.

Updated drawing for the Boat Launch Facility was presented to the council.

Lance gave report.

Sellers & Associates would like authorization to submit applications on behalf of the Town of Leonville through the American Rescue Plan Act.

On a motion made by Kerry Willingham, duly seconded by Benita Kennerson, and carried authorizing Sellers & Associates to submit applications for Water Projects through the American Rescue Plan Act.

On a motion made by Billy Lanclos, duly seconded by Kirk Stelly, and carried authorizing Sellers & Associates to submit applications for Sewer Projects through the American Rescue Plan Act.

Kendal Sylvester addressed the council concerning his water bill for 5193 Hwy 31, verified a work order was already submitted and that should be resolved within a few days. Would contact when information received.


Precilla Sassau addressed the council requesting any ideas to help children/people in the community. Example: mentoring, tutoring, food pantry etc.
