

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEONVILLE, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 10, 2025, AT 6:00 PM IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville was held on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter, Council Members Benita Kennerson, Billy Lanclos, Kerry Willingham, Kirk Stelly and Amanda Herpin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Amanda Herpin, seconded by Kirk Stelly, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

Albert Quebedeaux, moved a 1994 Mobile Home to 295 Marcel St, passed inspection by Building Code Inspection Service. On a motion by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Benita Kennerson, and all in favor to allow mobile home to stay in town. Mr. Quebedeaux will purchase proper permits Wednesday, June 11th.

Stephanie Briggs with Sellers & Associates presented bids for 2023 Street Improvement Phase 2 received on May 21st. Motion by Billy Lanclos, seconded by Kerry Willingham to award bid to Apeck Construction. Change Order No. 1, subject to approval by FP&C will reduce the contract price by \$163,405.50 for final contract price of \$522,433.00.

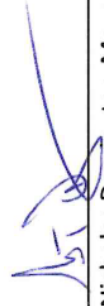

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OPERATING BUDGET OF
REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2025

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen, of the Town of Leonville, Louisiana in
general convened that:

SECTION I. The attached detailed estimate of Revenues for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025, be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as an Operating Budget of Revenues for the Town of Leonville, Louisiana during the same periods.

SECTION II. The attached estimate of Expenditures by departments for the Fiscal Year amended estimate for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025, be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as a budget of expenditures for the Town of Leonville, Louisiana during the same period.

SECTION III. The adoption of the Operating Budget of Expenditures be and the same is hereby declared to operate as an appropriation of the amount therein set forth within the terms of the budget classification.

SECTION IV. Amounts are available for expenditures only to the extent included within the 2023-2024 amended budget.

SECTION V. The Mayor of the Town of Leonville shall have the authority to make changes within various budget classifications as well as the transfer of funds between departments and funds without approval by the governing authority.
