
Blake Davis FD5 report. Final inspection made for new tanker truck, Fire Department will cook hot dogs for July 4th Fireworks Display.

ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OPERATING BUDGET OF
REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING JULY 1, 2023 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2024

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen, of the Town of Leonville, Louisiana in general convened that:

SECTION I. The attached detailed estimate of Revenues for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024, be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as an Operating Budget of Revenues for the Town of Leonville, Louisiana during the same periods.

SECTION II. The attached estimate of Expenditures by departments for the Fiscal Year amended estimate for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024, be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as a budget of expenditures for the Town of Leonville, Louisiana during the same period.

SECTION III. The adoption of the Operating Budget of Expenditures be and the same is hereby declared to operate as an appropriation of the amount therein set forth within the terms of the budget classification.

SECTION IV. Amounts are available for expenditures only to the extent included within the 2023-2024 amended budget.

SECTION V. The Mayor of the Town of Leonville shall have the authority to make changes within various budget classifications as well as the transfer of funds between departments and funds without approval by the governing authority.
