

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEONVILLE, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 10, 2026, AT 6:00 PM IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville was held on Tuesday, March 10, 2026, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter, Council Members Kirk Stelly, Kerry Willingham, Benita Kennerson, Billy Lanclos, and Amanda Herpin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Kirk Stelly, seconded by Kerry Willingham, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

Council discussed holding a sausage poby fundraiser on May 3, 2026, for 4th of July fireworks show. Bake sale as well.

Matthew Vincent with Sellers & Associates presented the following on the Street Project. On a motion by Kerry Willingham, duly seconded by Amanda Herpin, and all in favor of approving Partial Payment Estimate No. 2 to Apeck Construction in the amount of \$149,881.85 and Partial Payment Estimate No. 3 to Apeck Construction in the amount of \$112,970.31.

WWTP improvements project discussed. Motion by Kirk Stelly, seconded by Billy Lanclos, and all in favor of approving Contract Change Order No. 1 to reduce the contract price by \$148,440.00 for a final contract price of \$455,500.00.

MWPP Audit Report was presented. On a motion by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Amanda Herpin, and duly resolved, the following resolution was offered and adopted:

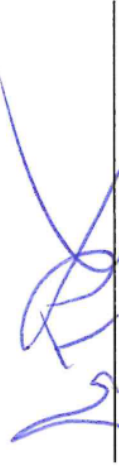
Council member Benita Kennerson requested maintenance department address potholes on Marcel Street.
