

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEONVILLE, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON MONDAY, MAY 13, 2024, AT 6:00 PM IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville was held on Monday, May 13, 2024, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter, Council Members Kirk Stelly, Amanda Herpin, Benita Kennerson, Billy Lanclos and Kerry Willingham.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Benita Kennerson, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

April Lafleur addressed the council concerning Jared Declouet, 238 Hurvey St. Dogs barking is better, goats are gone, horses still there with bad smell. Mayor informed Mr. Declouet that next complaint received will result in fine of \$150.00, if fine not paid, sentence of 10 days in jail according to Ordinance No. 1 of 2007.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have reviewed the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention Environmental Audit Report which is attached to this resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Leonville to set forth the following actions necessary to maintain the permit requirements contained in the Louisiana Water Discharge Permit (LPDES) number LA0114740.

1. Continue to maintain the collection and treatment facility.
